## It takes 3 steps:



#### HPV VACCINE

Give the HPV vaccination to children and young adults aged 9-26





#### **SCREENING**

Get regular
HPV/Pap test to
screen for
cervical cancer
beginning at
age 21





#### FOLLOW-UP/ TREATMENT

If your HPV/Pap test is abnormal, go back to your doctor/health care provider for a follow-up appointment

Provide employees with educational materials monthly or quarterly via email or mail\*

Consider adding information on Cervical Cancer and HPV in the New Hire Packet

Consider hosting a
health fair or lunch
and learn and invite a
health care
professional to provide
education and answer
questions
about HPV
vaccination,
screening,
and
follow-up

Consider offering paid time off for employees to get screened for cervical cancer Collaborate with a local clinic to schedule a mobile cervical cancer screening unit on-site to facilitate cervical cancer screening
