

WIPE OUT CERVICAL CANCER IN 3 STEPS

1

GET THE HPV VACCINATION -

The vaccine protects girls AND boys from the HPV virus, which prevents cervical cancer and protects against five others cancers. The first dose is recommended at 9 years old, before exposure to the virus.

GET SCREENED FOR CERVICAL CANCER -

Women aged 21-65 should get a HPV/ Pap test regularly. When pre-cancer or cancer is found early it is more treatable.

BE SURE TO FOLLOW UP WITH ANY ABNORMAL RESULTS -

The follow-up visit is very important. Not going back to the doctor can lead to serious illness or even death.

Cervical cancer can be eliminated in our lifetime with these three steps.

Over 90 percent of all cervical cancers are caused by HPV.
